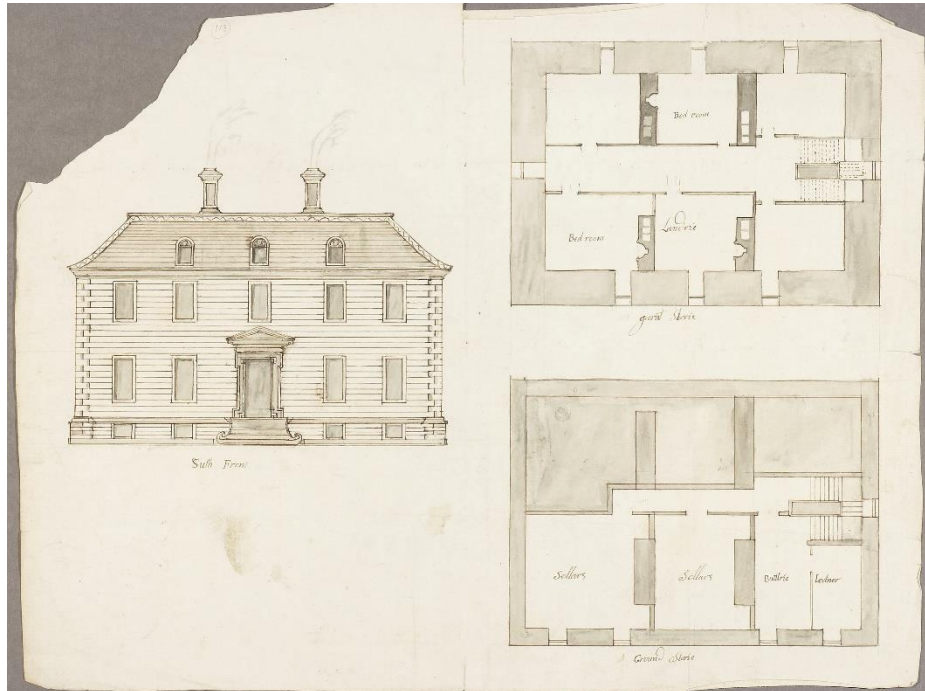

Our evening will take the usual format of talk and tour, and a buffet followed by an art and architecture quiz.

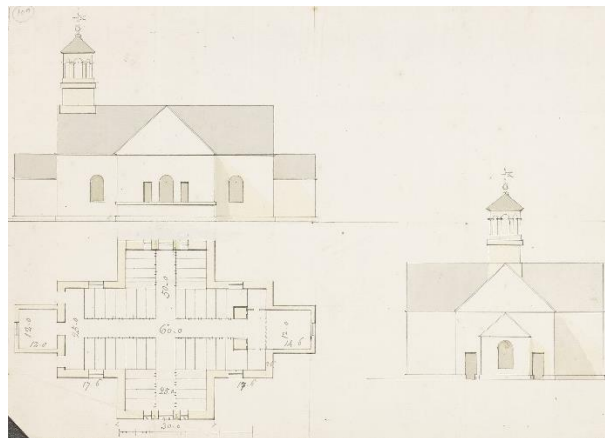

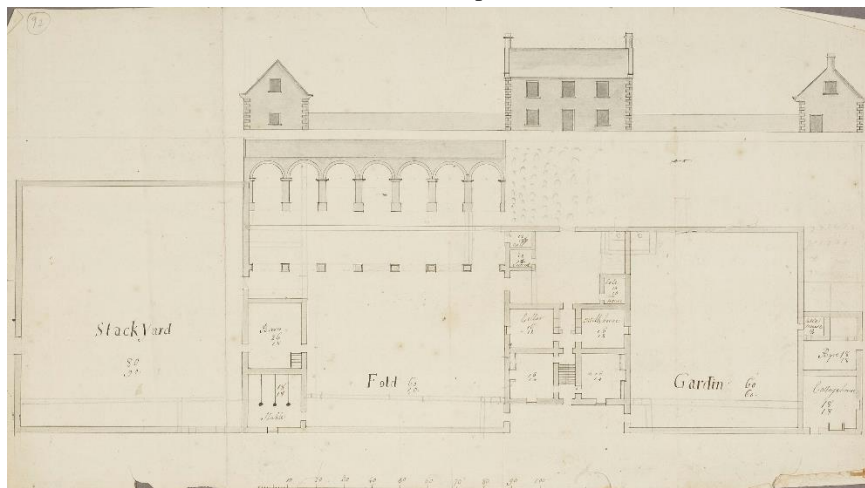
