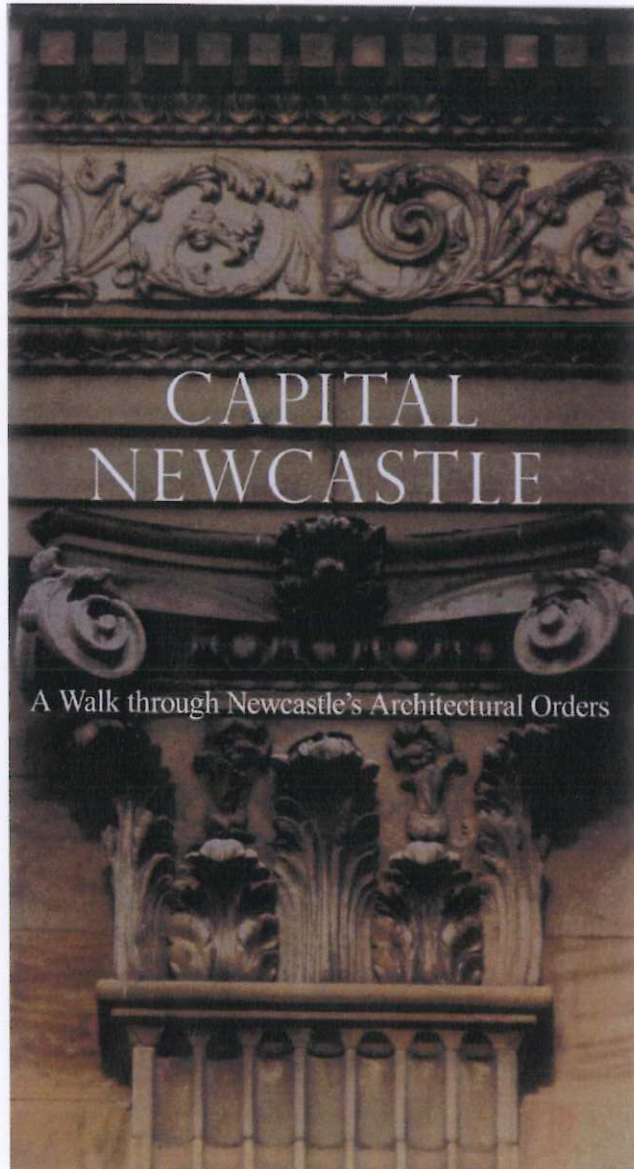

In September 2018 members were issued with Alan Beale's excellent pamphlet 'Capital Newcastle – a Walk Through Newcastle's Architectural Orders'. If you can lay hands on yours please bring it along to this event, in which we will follow elements of Alan's guide to these fascinating but often overlooked details of our architectural heritage. If you can't find it, come along anyway as I have a few spares. Starting at All Saints' we will drop down to the Guildhall on the quayside, then up to the Moot Hall and around the southern part of the town centre up to the Assembly Rooms. From there I will lead the party up to Leazes Terrace, but those who fear this would be too much to manage will be able to proceed to the Grainger Market where we will reunite for the latter part of the walk, taking in Grey Street, Pilgrim Street and ending in Northumberland Street some time between 4:00 and 4:30 p.m.

Those of a particularly enthusiastic disposition might care to join me at St. Anne's Church at 1:40 p.m. for a look at its portico by way of an aperitif to the main event.

This is an entirely outdoor event. Face masks and social distancing will be optional. Comfortable walking shoes are advised, along with an umbrella (although if it is absolutely chucking it down we will postpone). Please note that the route involves some steep hills and flights of steps.

To get the best out of this event bring binoculars, a camera with a telephoto lens, or both,

If travelling to the city by car, note that the quayside will be closed for the Sunday market. The Manor multi-storey car park is well placed between the start and finish of our walk – open until 6:00 p.m. on Sundays with an all-day charge of £3:00.

Public toilets are available in the Eldon Square shopping complex close to the north-west corner of the Grainger Market, which represents the mid-point of our tour.
