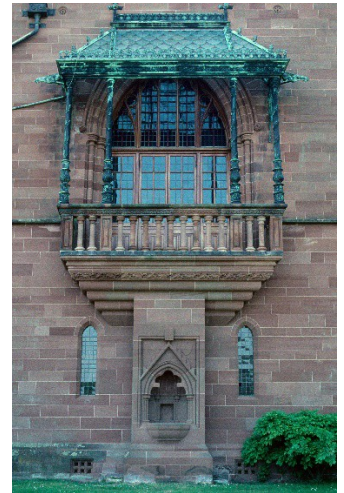


NORTHERN ARCHITECTURAL HISTORY SOCIETY

Membership is by annual subscription, due for renewal on 1st March each year.

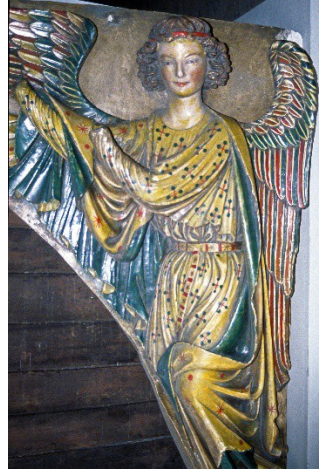
